**CIRCULAR**

**Subject: India's G20 Presidency from 01.12.2022 to 30.11.2023 – Regd.**

From 1<sup>st</sup> December 2022, India has become the President of the G20 for the first time which is a historic opportunity for the country. G20 is a premier forum for international economic cooperation representing around 85% of the global GDP, over 75% of the worldwide trade and about two-thirds of the world population. The Presidency of G20 is a matter of pride for every Indian.

**2. The theme of India's G20 presidency:**

- The theme of India's G20 Presidency – "Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam" or "One Earth – One Family – One Future" – is drawn from the ancient Sanskrit text of the Maha Upanishad. Essentially, the theme affirms the value of all life – human, animal, plant, and microorganisms – and their interconnectedness on the planet Earth and in the wider universe.
- The theme also spotlights LiFE (Lifestyle for Environment), with its associated, environmentally sustainable and responsible choices, both at the level of individual lifestyles as well as national development, leading to globally transformative actions resulting in a cleaner, greener and bluer future.
- The theme conveys a powerful message of India's G20 Presidency, which is of striving for just and equitable growth for all in the world, as we navigate through these turbulent times, in a sustainable, holistic, responsible, and inclusive manner. It represents a uniquely Indian approach to our G20 Presidency, of living in harmony with the surrounding ecosystem.
- The discussions in G20 are held through two parallel tracks i.e, Financial Track and Sherpa Track. Education is included in Goal 4 of Sustainable Developments Goals (SDGs) and is discussed through Sherpa Track.

**3. G20 awareness initiatives for schools under NDMC**

**3.1** Month-wise activities have been scheduled for the students between December 2022 to November 2023 to create awareness about G20 and its significance under India's Presidency.

**3.2** A dedicated G20 day shall be celebrated the day before last working day of every month.

**3.3** Hon'ble LG, CM/Dy. CM, Delhi, Chairman/Dy. Chairman, NDMC and senior officials/eminent personalities may be invited to grace and encouragement of the students of NDMC schools.

**3.4** Visit of school's children may be organized in consultation with the concerned embassy as well as MEA with discriminate the information to the undersigned to learn the lifestyle of concerned country.

**4.** 29 selected schools will be designated as 29 countries (20 member countries + 9 guest countries), who will participate in model Sherpa meeting(s)/model G20 Submit

in sync with G20. Nomination of the countries to different schools under NDMC to perform month-wise activities on the subjects as mentioned at **para 4**.
